Best Practice - 1

Title of the Practice:

INCULCATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSCIOUSNESS AND AWARENESS.

Objective of the Practice:

The college aims at inculcating environmental consciousness and awareness among students.

Context:

The college itself is nestled in the pristine environmental setup, surrounded by greenery along the banks of river Ganga. As such, the college aims to inculcate and engross students via activities and programmes related to environmental awareness.

The Practice:

- (a) College committees (EBSB, NSS, NCC, etc.) ensure the dissemination of this awareness amongst the students.
- (b) The Namami Ganga Samiti of the college vigorously pursues the agenda of clean Ganga and actively ensures the participation of the college students in leading the cleanliness drives along the banks; diya lighting ceremonies are also held along the Ganga Ghats to arise a sense of awareness amidst the students regarding the piety and cleanliness of the Ghats
- (c) Yoga, painting, cultural programmes, Cleanliness drives, etc. by the college students and faculties have been done frequently.
- (d) Various events held at the college like debates, poster displays and slogan writing competition naturally ensure to have environment related issues as the core themes for discussion.

Evidence of success:

- (a) Increase in awareness of students towards the cause gets reflected by the growing number of participants and enthusiasts in the events and activities.
- (b) Namami Ganga Samiti of college got felicitated at the local events by the district administration.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

- (a) A dedicated channel/link between the college and scientifically proven researchers and experts need to be developed to mitigate and address the imminent environmental issues.
- (b) Regular funding for environmental programs and campaigns need to be arranged.

Best Practice - 2

Title of the practice:

Promotion of ICT usage in college.

Objective of the Practice:

Keeping in view the objectives of NEP, knowledge of ICT is mandatory for the students and teachers alike.

Context:

The college has made tremendous changes in terms of teaching methodology regarding ICT usage. The post-covid era domain of education calls for more and more live dissemination of knowledge and demonstration of dexterity in education. The blend of ICT and tradition in the arena education is definitely the need of the hour and our college certainly aspires and strives to achieve it.

The Practice:

Problems encountered and resources required:

- (b) A dedicated advanced setup needs to build to minimize the technical glitches and updated ICT devices are needed.
